

Hello to all teams!

We are a few days away from the start of the 38th Ringette Boucherville Tournament, which will take place from January 14 to 19, 2025 at the Gilles Chabot Ice Center (565, boul. de Mortagne, Boucherville).

General information

- Your team arrives one hour before your game.
- Admission at a cost of \$5/day or \$10 for the duration of the tournament (free for under 18s).
- Payment in cash or by credit/debit card.
- Access to the corridors of the locker room controlled (only players and coaching staff will be able to access).
- Entrance is possible at the front of the arena only.
- Several prize draws will also be made among the participating teams in the tournament. The winning teams will contact and have to draw prizes among their players afterwards. The winning players will have to make sure to collect their prize before the end of the tournament (at the kiosk or registration office).
- On Saturday, January 18, an animation for young people will take place between ice cream 3 and 4 with games and prizes.
- If the paramedics have to use taping following an injury, it will be at the expense of the player between 5 and 10 \$ for the taping.

****IMPORTANT : locker rooms will be available 30 minutes before the game.****

Parking and shuttle

- Parking at the arena will be limited this year due to work done by the City of Boucherville at the rear of the arena.
- **We strongly suggest that, whenever possible, players be dropped off at the entrance of the arena and then go to park (see attached incentive parking plan).**
- Friday, January 17: shuttle bus between the Centre des glaces Gilles-Chabot and the Centre multifonctionnel Francine-Gadbois at 1075, Lionel-Daunais st (boarding points at the entrance of the arena and at the entrance of the multifunctional centre).
- Shuttle based on 9am to 4pm (end time to be confirmed) on Friday only.
- Parking lot of the De Mortagne secondary school only accessible from Friday 17h.

Food inside the arena

- Edward Smoked Meat will be on site serving dinner and supper on Friday, Saturday and Sunday noon.
- Our volunteers will also be on site to serve cold drinks and snacks.
- The arena restaurant unfortunately closed on December 30th, so outside food will also be allowed in the arena.

Photographer's Service

- All teams registered for the tournament will have a chance to win a sporting montage of their players. For one team, each of their players will receive a montage of a photo of them in action.

When you first enter the registry, we will give you:

- The gift bag for your players.
- Passes for all coaching members of your team for the duration of the tournament.
- The first game snack coupons.

When signing the match sheets, each team's coach will identify a lucky player who will receive a small gift at the end of the game.

It would be greatly appreciated if your coaching staff would all present themselves together when signing the match sheets at the registry! It is your responsibility to ensure that your coaching teams are compliant and certified before the event begins.

For teams that have exhibition matches, you must still present yourself to the registry for the signing of the match sheets with your team card, but no certification checks will be made with your coaching staff behind the bench.

Mandatory certification of coaches

- A hard copy of the official team card and a hard copy of the Reservists team card (if required).
- Valid proof of trainer certification (The Locker – Coach.ca) in hard copy

For Quebec teams:

- All coaches who have completed their SCI or CI course in recent years must be in good standing.
- Upon presentation of proof of registration for upcoming training, new coaches who have not completed their SCI or CI or Ethical Decision Making (EDP) training will be accepted behind the bench. However, the training course NCCP Coach Initiation in Sport must be completed (online training available for about 1 hour).
- The coaches' Ringette Québec identification cards to identify the coaches at the registration office (if not present on the official team card).

- If required, managers must have their Ringette Canada manager card.

For teams from outside of Quebec:

- A copy of your TRF approved by your provincial federation.
